

2008-2009 MC101R - ECU electrical connector re-connect instructions

You will notice that the connector in the new ECU is not the same as the old connector on your cart that is supposed to plug into it (this is because the Chinese manufacturer for some unknown reason, changed it on the spare parts order) go figure???

You have 2 options at this point:

1. A new compatible connector is included with your new ECU. You can cut off the old connector and splice the 5 wires matching the wire colors. Pin # 6 is not used. Then simply plug into the connector in the new ECU. Now continue with step 11 on the first page.
2. You can gently wiggle off the plastic part of the connector in the new ECU using pliers. The metal pins will stay in place as they are soldered to the circuit board. Now you can carefully line up the existing connector with the pins and press it down all the way to the circuit board. Now continue with step 11 on the first page.
